America is huge. Everyone knows that. However, many people don't really understand what that means. The United States of America is a very large country (1) many ways.

【 A 】 For example, when it is nine a.m. in New York, it is six a.m. in Los Angeles. A trip (2) plane from the *West Coast to the East will take six hours. However, flying from New York to Hawaii will take much ^①long.

Because (3) its size, the United States has many different *climates. These differences in nature also have influences (4) people's way of living, way of thinking and *attitudes about many things.

Second, 【 B 】 ^②It is amazing that so many things are covered not by *federal laws, but by *state laws. Also, laws do not stop at the state *level. Cities and towns also have their own laws.

School systems are different in some states. In some areas, for example, middle school has sixth-grade to eighth-grade students. In (5) areas, it may be from the fifth grade to the eighth. 【 C 】

You may hear or read information about America on TV and magazines in Japan. You must not *take it as general information. It will be right in only one *region. If you hear that “something is very popular in America,” 【 D 】 It may only be true for a very small group of people in one region. ^③A person living in a college town in California may say “Americans don't *care a lot about clothes. It's OK to go anywhere in just a T-shirt and *shorts.” But that may not be OK in a college town on the East Coast. It is not OK in New York City. If you really want to know about something in one region, the best way is to ask local people from there.

Arthur: I agree. I think it is important because happiness comes from things money can't buy.

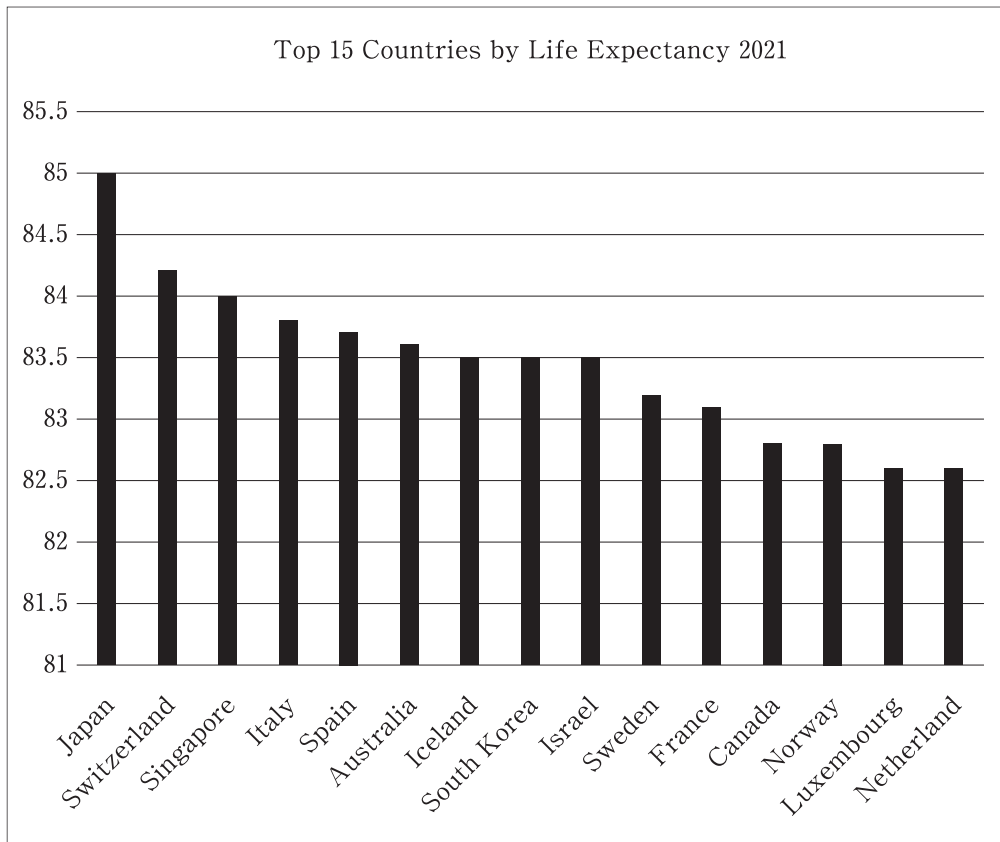
